Mr. Nair,

On this date, April 30, 2022, we appeal the results of the grama request for the following reasons. This appeal will also be made with the State of Utah Government Records Ombudsman.

We feel that the GRAMA request was not completed properly and did not include all the information requested in the initial request. Additional reasons include, but not limited to:

- The GRAMA was a self-auditing request for information and not automated or extracted data.
  - Email from City recorder to city councilors and representatives
- Emails that were shown to contain attachments did not include the attachment as a document that was delivered.
- March 30, 2021 there was a stakeholder meeting with Vineyard City and LRS and there is no record of it or minutes in GRAMA.
  - This was included in the ULR application as Appendix A (Stakeholder Coordination)
- Meeting w/ Mayor Fullmer and Robert Scott on June 14, 2021.
- Concern over personal email use and documentation not fully being disclosed.
- Lack of information concerning the support and promise of 5 million dollars in taxpayer funds. How this came to be, discussion and follow up acceptance of letter of support.
- Where was the request for information made to Jeff Hartley? Did he provide any documentation as part of this grama?
- Further documentation has been received from outside sources, that was not, and should have been, included in this request.
